Big Idea

Discussion Questions

- 1) What are some of the barriers people might face when encountering Jesus? Are there any assumptions that arise about cleaning up our lives beforehand? How does Jesus respond to our condition when we find Him/He finds us?
- 2) What does John 6:35-40 tell us about the will of God in relation to humanity? How does this shape our view of the world? How might God develop our heart for people who don't yet know Him?
- 3) Paul talks about the ongoing process of following Jesus in Colossians 2:6-7. What basic yet vital instruction do we get from these verses? How do you see this working out in your lives, and what steps can be taken to be "strengthened in the faith as you were taught"?
- 4) Paul tells us that we should be a people who overflow with thankfulness (v7b). Can you take a few moments to let thankfulness to God fill the conversation? How are you praising God for His faithfulness? What stories of Hope and Life could you amplify to the people around you?
- 5) If your group took time to work through the above question, how did it affect the feel of the room? What does thankfulness do to your soul?
- 6) Jesus is well acquainted with suffering (see Isaiah 53) and teaches what he actually does (Acts 1:1). How does Jesus live this out in his earthly ministry, and what does it teach us about our own journey?
- 7) Can you share a story about how you've seen an aspect of the character of Christ modeled in another person, be it a mom, dad, family member, teacher, coach, mentor, or friend?
